POLICY:

It is the policy of the Cobb County Community Services Board and the Douglas County Community Services Board's Behavioral Health Crisis Center to follow the guidelines of DBHDD Policy 01-347 detailing the requirements for certification and other applicable federal, state or local laws.

PROCEDURE:

- A. Sanctions are enforced based upon a finding that an applicant or certified BHCC has:
1. Knowingly made any verbal or written false statement of material fact either in connection with the application for a certification or on documents submitted to DBHDD as part of any inspection or investigation, or has falsified or altered records made or maintained by the BHCC;
 2. Failed or refused, without legal cause, to provide DBHDD with access to the premises subject to certification or with information pertinent to the initial and continued certification of the BHCC;
 3. Failed to comply with any certification or former DBHDD licensing requirements of this state; or
 4. Failed to comply with the provisions of state law, with any DBHDD standard, or with any provisions of DBHDD policy.
