

**POLICY:**

It is the policy of the Cobb County Community Services Board and the Douglas County Community Services Board to utilize valid and reliable assessment tools for use as methods of screening and assessing the severity of symptoms and level of functioning.

**PROCEDURE:**

1. In addition to meeting the requirements set forth by federal, state or other grant funded programs, the following assessment tools may be utilized for screening and assessing the severity of symptoms and level of functioning:

- AccuCare Substance Abuse Assessment
- ASAM
- ANSA/CANS
- ASI
- CAFAS – Child and Adolescent - Level of functioning
- Columbia Suicide Severity Rating Scale (C-SSRS)
- Criminal Justice Assessment
- GAF
- LOCUS
- HRST
- MICP – Determining severity of symptoms and level of functioning
- State-Trait Anger Expression Inventory - 2 - Interpretive Report
- The Strengths and Impairment Scale - Screening
- TIP 42
