POLICY:

It is the policy of the Cobb County Community Services Board to utilize the standing orders for medical detox from Alcohol, Benzodiazepines and Opiates when ordered by the physician.

PROCEDURE:

1. Upon admission to the BHCC or at any time during the stay, the attending physician/APRN may order the standing protocol for opiate detox to be instituted.
2. The name of the individual, individual identification number, date and time is to be included when completing the Alcohol, Benzodiazepines and Opiates Detox standing orders form. The physician/APRN will enter the date and time when he or she signs it. The nurse transcribes the order, notes the date and time that the order is transcribed, and signs his/her full name.
3. The Admission Orders for Alcohol, Benzodiazepines and Opiates detox are filed or scanned under the "Orders" section in the Clinical Record.
4. Any specific individual order may be omitted at the physician's/APRN's discretion by writing "Omit" by the order.
